As per approval of the Government vide No.A.12012/3/2023-FCS&CA dated 13.11.2024, applications are invited from interested eligible persons who fulfill the conditions listed below for appointment to the post of **Member** in the State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commissions on 'part-time' basis for a term of 4 (four) years or upto the age of 65 (sixty-five) years whichever is earlier as shown below: -

#### 1. Qualifications required-

- (1) A person shall not be qualified for appointment as a member of State Commission unless he is of **not less than forty years of age** and possesses
  - (a) An experience of at least ten years as presiding officer of a district court or of any tribunal at equivalent level or combined service as such in the district court and tribunal:
    - Provided that not more than fifty percent of such members shall be appointed; or
  - (b) A bachelor's degree from a recognised university and is a person of ability, integrity and standing, and has special knowledge and professional experience of not less than ten years in consumer affairs, law, public affairs, administration, economics, commerce, industry, finance, management, engineering, technology, public health or medicine:
  - (c) At least one member or the President of the State Commission shall be a woman.
- **2. Disqualification for appointment of member State Commission** A person shall be disqualified for appointment as Member of a State Commission if he—
  - (a) has been convicted and sentenced to imprisonment for an offence which involves moral turpitude; or

- (b) has been adjudged to be insolvent; or
- (c) is of unsound mind and stands so declared by a competent court; or
- (d) has been removed or dismissed from the service of the State Government or Central Government or a body corporate owned or controlled by such Government; or
- (e) has, in the opinion of the State Government, such financial or other interest as is likely to prejudicially affect his functions as the President or a member.
- 3. This appointment shall be made under the provisions of the 'Consumer Protection Act, 2019' and the 'Consumer Protection (Qualification for appointment, method of recruitment, procedure of appointment, term of office, resignation and removal of the President and members of the State Commission and District Commission) Rules, 2020' as amended from time to time and read with the 'Mizoram Consumer Protection (Salary, allowances and conditions of service of President and Members of the State Commission and District Commission) Rules, 2021' as amended from time to time.
- **4.** Selection of Member of the State and Commission will be made by the Selection Committee as prescribed in Rule 6 of the Consumer Protection (Qualification for appointment, method of recruitment, procedure of appointment, term of office, resignation and removal of the Presidents and members of the State Commission and District Commission) Rules, 2020 which are made under the provisions of the Consumer Protection Act, 2019.
- **5. Oaths of office and secrecy -** Every person appointed to be a Member, before entering upon his office make and subscribe an oath of office and secrecy in Form I and II annexed.
- **6.** Every appointment of a President or member shall be subject to submission of a certificate of physical fitness as indicated in the annexure appended to these rules, duly signed by a civil surgeon or District Medical Officer.
- 7. The eligibility criteria, tenure and qualification will be according to the provisions laid down in the above said Act and Rules. Only applications received till the cut-off date, i.e., 16<sup>th</sup> of December, 2024 and complete in all aspects and with all requisite documents attached shall be considered. Hard copy of the application and information on the aforementioned Act and Rules can be sought from the Consumer Affairs Branch, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, Directorate of Food, Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Treasury Square, Aizawl during office hours.
- 8. Relevant original documents may be produced by the applicants at the time of interview.

There will be a **written examination** for the selection of President and Members of the State and District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commissions. This examination will be conducted as per rule 6(9) of the Consumer Protection (Qualification for appointment, method of recruitment, procedure of appointment, term of office, resignation and removal of the President and members of the State Commission and District Commission) Amendment Rules, 2023.
